# Next Stop. . . Nashville!



Good news for everyone on the West side of the county! The Bookmobile now has a weekly stop at Nashville Elementary School on Thursdays from 3-4:20 pm through May. Beginning in June, the hours will be 5:30-6:30 pm. Patrons are welcome to stop by and browse our collection on the Bookmobile, use a laptop computer and surf the web, or request an item from the catalog that will be brought to you at

the Nashville stop. There is also a Holmes County Library Book Return located there as well so you can easily return your materials at your convenience.

In addition, the Bookmobile also has weekly stops in Winesburg on Mondays from 2:30-6:30

pm and Berlin on Wednesdays from 3-6 pm. Through May, the Killbuck stop is Thursdays from 4:45-6:30 pm with the hours changing to 3:00-5:15 pm in June.
