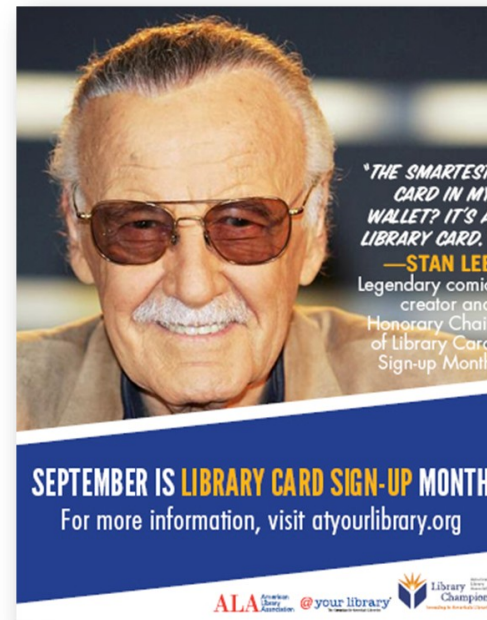

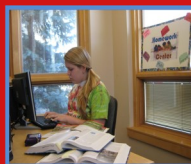

Several changes with the children's collection have taken place over the past few months in order to make browsing easier for patrons. You may notice the children's **audio-books** are now shelved with the **chapter books**. We've moved the **graphic novels** to a different location to allow this collection to expand. We've pulled some of your favorite subjects and characters, and placed them together for easy browsing. **Amelia Bedelia**, **LEGO®**, **Star Wars** and **Superhero** books from the EZ Reader, Picture Book and Nonfiction sections can now be found in their own special place on the shelves. There is also a **Quick Picks for Kids** section which includes readily available popular books and videos for limited check-out.
