These AUBRY's were settled in Salt Creek Twp, Holmes Co for the 1880 USC.

MARIE's marriage record is the sole source for FRANCOIS' given name and his wife URSULA's maiden name. MARIE must have died not long after the marriage, since Theodore Girard was married to Felicie Genet in 1858.

The Lombards lived in Portsmouth.

This family was settled in Paint Twp, Wayne Co.

JEAN Baptiste entered the USA in 1839, and JEAN Claude also (1900 USC), most probably when the entire family entered.

JOHN & MARY had the above dates for their births in the 1900 USC. But in previous, less specific, censuses JOHN's given age would indicate a birth in either 1830/31/32. The 1880 USC has MELANIE's birth c 1873. This could be the same child; the census taker could have heard *seven* instead of *eleven* for her age; or the above one could have died and another was given the name.

A Paul Bardin died 5 Oct 1888 at Calmoutier (the above?). A Virginia Vigar (?), who was born in Vesoul 17 Jan 1813 and died at Calmoutier 12 Nov 1889 is MARY's mother. MARY FIGARD was born in Ohio (USC), while JOHN Claude entered the USA in 1839 (USC). He was a blacksmith and with his family was settled in Paint Twp, Wayne Co.

Elise, VICTOR's oldest sister, lived with this family, which was settled on their father's farm in Salt Creek Twp, Holmes Co. While EDWARD's godmother, she was known as *Marraine* to all (SBf).

VICTOR's parrain was *Peter Victor Jeanmougin*, 8 months older than Elise and their 2nd cousin, though closer than most 1st cousins; for he lived, played, and grew up with Elise in the same French village, and asked for her presence, when on his deathbed. *Dora Minder*

The above are all the known members of the family of SIMON & CLAUDINE. This elder SIMON's sister was the mother of J François Jeanmougin, her only child, and accompanied his family, together with her second husband, Joseph Sarazin, to the United States, arriving at New York on board the Monument 10 June 1844. (The passenger list, written in a hard-to-decipher hand, has as her given name what may be *Danielle*; but it clearly states she was born c March 1767.) Louis Joseph Besançon, a Capuchin monk, was the son of either FRANCOIS or FELIX. *SBf*

*SBf* has *Tobelin* instead of *JOBLIN* for CLAUDINE's surname; and *Gaiville* instead of *Gavaille*, for the surname of Frances, the younger SIMON's wife.

The younger SIMON was born in Velotte, an adjoining village of Amblans, Lure; Haute-Saône, France. *SBf*

FRANCES' father was Francois, who had a brother, Claude Francois (*SBf*; which also has *Gaiville* for *Gavoille*).

SIMON's aunt was J Francois Jeanmougin's mother. Both SIMON & FRANCES were born in Velotte, Lure; Haute-Saone, France. They lived in Bouhans-les-Lure when they emigrated for America in 1847. It was a six-week voyage on the ship Crotons from the port of Le Havre. They settled near Clark, Mechanic Twp, Holmes Co; in 1854 in Knox Co near the Mohican River; in 1863 at Stillwell's Corner near Wolf Creek; and in 1874 on the 80-acre Pomerene farm, Salt Creek Twp, Holmes Co. *SBf*

Except for EUGENE, born in Fulton Co, all the children were born at Calmoutier (*PMf*. But *StG* has recorded only the baptisms of CHARLES, JOSEPH, and ELIZABETH.)

After joining the army in the fall of 1862, AUGUSTE was sent to Mississippi, where he contracted a fever and died the following year. He's buried in Vicksburg. *PMf*

CHARLES settled in Fredericksburg. The others moved to Cheboygan Co, Michigan, where ELIZABETH is buried in Calvary Cemetery. Many descendants lived in Sacred Heart Parish in Riggsville, near Alverno. JOSEPH's grandson, Stanislaus Bur (1920- ) is a priest. *PMf*

MARGUERITE was one of a family of five born in France, along with Francois, Joseph, Madeline, and Elizabeth (Mrs. Pierre Joseph Simon, mother of Julia--Mrs. Julius C. Dete, and Mary Ann--Mrs. Aristide Bresson). They came from France and settled in Richland Twp, near Glenmont, in the 1840's. *Fort Fizzle* was located on the BLANCHAT farm. AOf

The above represents all the known pioneer BOIGEGRAINS at Calmoutier. They all appear related, and the probability is good that the relationship is precisely as given above: a husband and wife with 5 sons. The 1840 Census named only the head of a family; and in this case, it indicated that a wife and 3 sons were living with FRANCOIS in Salt Creek Twp, Wayne Co.

Incredible as it may seem, BOIGEGRAIN has been spelled *BUSGAR* and *BERSDAUT* in the Census. It was pronounced *Busgy* (the *u* as in *bush*) in 1900 (says Blanche Walter Meyer), and for this reason this family has been difficult to track. But since FRANCIS was the parrain of Euphrasie Marthey (baptized 22 Feb 1835 and recorded at St John's in Canton), it can be assumed they were charter members of StG and among the earliest arrivals at Calmoutier.

The surname of Marguerite, AUGUSTINE's wife, has been spelled *Steg?ent*, *Stregen*, *Stepent*, and *Camelat* (the latter suggesting a previous marriage?).

While Jean Claude's wife may have been deceased, he brought his family to Calmoutier in 1848, where they lived on a farm in Paint Twp, Wayne Co. His will of 1859 names the six married children above and their spouses, but not MELANIE, PAULINE, or JOSEPHINE, known only in *JCf*.

*JCf* notwithstanding, the order of births here is simply unknown. And Basilide was not a *Stutz*, but instead, the daughter of Eugene & Benigne Girard. The Henris moved to Delaware Co, Iowa, near Dubuque, and the Jeanmougins lived in Algiers, North Africa.

"The 13th of December 1748 Nicole Martin died in communion with the church aged about 60 years and the following day her body was interred in the cemetery in the presence of Jacques and Jean Claude Chenevaix her illiterate sons and several others."

A Jacques was born 3 October 1743 to JACQUES CHENEVAIX & Louise Mathiez (the sponsors being Bacque Coillot and Elisabeth Bechorin, *illitérés*). Now it is certainly possible for JACQUES and Jean Claude to have wives with the same name (for Félicien's mother was Marie Françoise Jeanmougin, and his mother-in-law Françoise Jeanmougin, of no known relationship). Or Jean Claude could also have had the given name *Jacques*, a common enough practice, and the Jacques, then, born in 1743 would be his. Or, even more common than that, the recorder simply made a mistake.

NICOLE MARTIN is the great-grandmother of Félicien Chenevey through Jean Claude & Louise Mathiez.

The above information was gleaned in Vesoul from the Archives Départementales de la Haute-Saône. The one register, 3 E 81 2, contained all the information; but undoubtedly there are other children, at least in a previous register. The researcher was primarily interested in Félicien's direct rather than collateral relationships.

In the eight recorded entries above (the births of the twins being counted as one), the surname is spelled CHENEVAIX five times, and CHENEVAY thrice.

There may well be more children in this family. The above were found in Registers 3 E 14 1 & 2 in the Archives Départementales de la Haute-Saône at Vesoul. In eight entries (including ANTOINE's witness of Marguerite Pahin's birth) the surname is spelled CHENEVAY six times and CHENEVAIS twice.

In NICOLAS' death record a Joseph Paheins is listed as a relative. A Nicolas Jeanmougin (c 1746- ) witnessed Claude Francois' birth, and an Etienne Aubry (c 1751- ) Marie Antoinette's.

NICOLAS is presumed to have been born before 1793, since the researcher did not come across his birth in the registers following that date.

By profession ANTOINE was a cartmaker (*charon*), and also a plowman (*laboureur*).

This family came from Amblans, Lure; Haute-Saone, France. They first appear at StG in March 1848, and on 3 May the children were enrolled in an association of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, for the conversion of sinners, the same year they immigrated to the USA (USC).

On 22 May 1848 FELICIEN bought some land in Paint Twp, Wayne Co from Philip Zigler for \$2,500; a part of the southwest corner of section 20, township 15, range 11. Two weeks later he sold 18 acres to the Jeanmougins, who had already been there four years. Along with the Roussel, Pierson, and Cholley families these CHENEVEYs also donated land for the congregation of St Genevieve (StGh).

FRANCES PAGIN, whose surname is known only from HORTENSE's death certificate, is almost certainly the sister of Marguerite *Pahin* (StG spelling), the wife of Nicholas Girard. However, there is no indication of any relationship with Anne Pagin (1804-1870 and buried at Glenmont), the wife of Jean Claude Mougin (apparently unrelated to the Jeanmougins), who was settled in Mechanic Twp, Holmes Co. FRANCES is unknown after the 1850 USC.

The above represents the known family of FELICIEN & FRANCES, who are the ancestors of every CHENEVEY from Calmoutier.

This family farmed in Calmoutier until 1917, when they purchased a farm one and one-half miles south of Wadsworth. Five months after the move, PETER died. Six years later, they moved to 413 Broad St, Wadsworth.

PMf

In December of 1791 at St-Sauveur, Lure; Haute-Saone, France, Francis Cholley was born. His parents, Peter Antonio Chollet & Jeanne Marie Causet, were peasants, while he, himself, grew up to be a weaver. This was during the French Revolution, when anarchy reigned, and law and religion carried little prestige.

It was precisely these circumstances, though, which occasioned his marriage. As all young, unmarried men were compelled to serve in the army, his parents thought it wise for him to choose the alternative, Matrimony. "In Frances Jeanvoine, who lived across the street in the little village, they saw the most logical prospect. So, on a Sunday morning in May, the parents appeared at the Jeanvoine home. Without any preliminaries they stated the object of their coming by simply saying, 'Well, we came to ask if we can have your Frances for our Francis.'" The answer can be inferred from the statement on the marriage certificate: "On June 2, 1813 Francis Cholley was very solemnly married to Frances Jeanvoine."

For 21 years they lived together in that same little village. It was here that 10 of their 12 children were born: Adelaide, Peter, Louise, Frances, Sebastien, Julie, Mary, Sophie, Eugenie, and Paul.

Then, around June of 1834, they left behind them the turbulent state of affairs in France and emigrated to America. *Cholley* was the spelling of Francis' surname on his passport. During the voyage across the ocean, Josephine was born, the 11th of Francis' 12 children. The 12th, Melanie, was born at Calmoutier, Ohio.

On their arrival they stayed with the Peter Taudiws. Subsequently, they owned a 40-acre farm in Paint Twp, Wayne Co, near Mt Eaton, and then a farm in Holmes Co. Francis died May 20, 1857; his wife, Frances, born c 1792 (1850 USC), died on March 16 1888. Peter F Jeanvoine, born c 1797, was her younger brother.

In a double wedding ceremony, AUGUSTINE's sister, Adelaide Cagnet, married Auguste Francois Jeanvoine on the same above date.

On 14 Jul 1907 at St Genevieve's, after vespers and benediction, begun at 5 PM, a large procession proceeded to the new cemetery for the blessing of the Curcifix. The iron-bronze corpus, imported from France, was donated by SEBASTIEN CHOLLEY (then 87). Carpentry on the cross itself, which is white oak, was done by Joseph F Marthey in the summer of 1907. The base of the cross was cemented by Joseph Bresson and Ed Rouhier. *StG*

On his arrival in the USA in May 1875, Joseph Semonin stayed with this family, with whom he became quite close. He was best man at PAUL & Mary's wedding (*Dora Minder*), and had PAUL as parrain for his first-born child, Jennie.

CATHERINE's will, proved 28 Apr 1857, names VINCENT, ANTOINE, and FRANCOIS MENUEZ, in the order given, as her three sons.

The 1850 Census indicates that this couple lived alone in Salt Creek Twp, Holmes Co. It has *JENTY* for their surname, which was often spelled *GENTIL* in the account books.

29 Jun 1833 an *Antonie Shantee* bought 40 acres of the north half of the east half quarter of the southwest quarter of section 25, twp 15, range 12 from Conrad Simmerman. If this is the above, then the GENTITs were among the earliest settlers of Calmoutier.

An unsigned 1891 entry in the front fly leaf of the 1st sacramental records book states: "Rev Lamy's first mass was read in the Gentile's house." *Lamy*, priest first appears in the same book 1 Aug 1839. Fr John Baptist Lamy attended Calmoutier from Danville, Knox Co until at least 10 May 1841. In 1853 he became the 1st bishop of Santa Fe, and in 1875 its 1st archbishop, which post he held until his death in 1888. He later became widely known as the subject of Willa Cather's novel *Death Comes for the Archbishop*.

While EUGENE is almost certainly the brother of Nicholas Girard (1801-79), BENIGNE does not appear to be related to any other Bressons. Moreover, Theodore Jeanmougin's mother, Jeanne Claude Bresson, is expressly unrelated (*StG*).

EUGENE & BENIGNE are buried at Calmoutier, but the dates of death are unclear.

While their three sisters are buried at Calmoutier, FRANCIS, SOPHIA, and THEOPHILUS moved to Iowa. THEOPHILUS in 1875 located near the village of Arbor Hill, Adair Co; SOPHIA also moved about the same time, but eventually settled at Riverside; FRANCIS followed in 1877, and like his brother, settled near Arbor Hill.

NICHOLAS is almost surely the brother of Eugene Girard (c 1802-78 and next to whom he is buried), both closely associated with the family of Joseph Malcuit & Augustina Potot; but there is no apparent relationship to Theodore Girard (c 1821-97), who is buried at Glenmont. MARGUERITE is the sister of Mrs Félicien Chenevey.

The above GIRARDS and Cheneveys arrived in NY 24 Apr 1848 on board the *Nicolas*. Nine days later, on the 3rd of May, except for Pauline they are enrolled at StG in an association of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. They were all born in the district of Lure; Hte-Saône, France (USC). They settled in Salt Creek Twp, Wayne Co.

PAUL and HUBERT have GAR on their tombstones. PAUL is also listed in the *Ohio Civil War Roster*. His regiment participated in the Siege and Battle of Vicksburg.

This family lived in Salt Creek Twp, Wayne Co for the 1880 USC, which provided the approximate ages for the then living members of the family. All the above were born in Ohio, except for *EULALIE* (France) and two of the children, *MARY* and *JOHN* (Indiana). *USC*

*CELINA* and those younger (except for *JANE*) have their baptisms recorded at Calmoutier, where *MARY* was wedded to Julien Martin Sr 8 Feb 1887. *EUGENE* married a Mary Sawler 22 Aug 1921 in Pulaski, Indiana. *StG*

*MARY* and her husband settled at Ft Wayne, Indiana after their marriage. *FMf*

JEAN's will lists the above order of 4 sons and 2 daughters. Other heirs (of other offspring?) include Rosalia Grojean of New Hamburg; Josephine; Mary (c 1849-), wife of Frank Diebold; Louisa (c 1847- ), wife of Ignace Diebold; Charles (c 1850- ); Henry (c 1852- ); Constantine (c 1854- ); and Amalia (c 1856/7- ). They all spell their name *Grojean*, but everyone else spells it *Gros-jean*! heavily influenced, no doubt, by the many Protestant Swiss (USC) Grosjeans in the area. The above GROJEANS came from France (USC and StG).

The earliest *recorded* death at StG is that of a Matthew Bigey (c 1770 - 1 Dec 1849), widower, it says, of Catharine Simonin (perhaps a g-aunt of Joseph Semonin, whose surname StG and others usually spell as Catharine's). They're probably the parents of MARIE Julienne.

FRANCOIS always signed himself *Jeanmougin*, and like his son, P VICTOR, was buried with the name. JEANNE was a sister to Mrs Francois Rouhier, Pierre and Charles Bresson. Charles' passport, dated 4 May 1844 from Le Havre, names his ship - *S Moument*, and his place of birth - *Amblans*, Lure; Haute-Saone, France.

An only child (*SBf*), FRANCOIS brought his family to America in June 1844. On 3 July he bought 60 acres of land in Paint Twp, Wayne Co (west side of the south-west quarter of section 20, twp 15, range 11) from Andrew Myer for \$1,900. On 14 Oct FRANCOIS and a Joseph Sarasin enrolled in an association of the Immaculate Heart (*StG*). His mother, nee Besancon/Joblin, was the aunt of Simon Besancon. After her husband's death, she married a Sarazin (Joseph?) and came to Calmoutier, Ohio, where she died and was buried (*SBf*).

PETER is known only in the 1860 USC (the family being absent from the 1850 USC). Any relationship: to Jean Claude Mougin (never *Jeanmougin* and present before 1836) is unlikely; and to Jean Francois Jeanmougin, spouse of Louise Cagnet and living in Algiers, Africa, is simply unknown.

*PMf*, a primary source for this family, has them ultimately coming from Epinal; Vosges (immediately north of Lure; Hte-Saône) in old Lorraine. They arrived at NY on the ship *America* 12 Aug 1833, and may be counted among the earliest settlers of Calmoutier. PIERRE's father is said to have been Nicholas, a teacher.

JOSEPH, naturalized 30 Sep 1867, swore he was born 15 Sep 1827 (*PMf* has 12 Oct for the twins). *PMf* also has *Charles Blank* for Auguste Blanc, who joined the army in 1862 and died of a fever during the siege of Vicksburg, where he is buried.

PIERRE was one of three trustees elected by the congregation of StG to administer the church 14 Nov 1847, the 1st such election. CLAUDINE was godmother for the 1st bell baptized for the new church 1 Nov 1849. They are the ancestors of every MARTHEY from Calmoutier, and lived in Salt Creek Twp, Wayne Co.

Lucinda (6 Apr 1843 - 9 May 1870, according to her tombstone) was married to Alexander Leguillon and may be EULALIE/Marie Frances above, who, along with AUGUSTINE, were baptized by Fr Louis DeGoesbriand from Louisville, who became the 1st Chancellor of Cleveland and the 1st Bishop of Burlington, Vermont. Jean Claude, as well as EULALIE/Marie Frances, was absent from the Census--presumably deceased. ANNE and LUCINDA are buried at Glenmont. They had lived in Mechanic Twp, Holmes Co.

This family does not seem to have ever been known as *Jeanmougin*; nor is there a trace of relationship with the Jeanmougins, or with Frances *Pagin* Ch-nevey, or with Marguerite *Pahin* Girard. *AOf* is the primary source for this family. ALEXANDRE was born in Pomoy, while BARBE was born in the neighboring village of Genevreville, Lure; Haute-Saone, France. Early in 1848 they came to America, and on 25 May 1848 bought land in Salt Creek Twp, Wayne Co, from Frederick Penot. About 1852 they moved to Black Creek in Richland Twp, Holmes Co. *AOf*

*AOf* (pp 160-1) has two dates for ADELAIDE's birth, the other being 28 May 1845. It has MARY born 26 Oct 1852 at Black Creek (p 176), and on p 13 in Wayne Co. *StG* has her above date of birth, which is supported by *USC*.

Possible relatives include: Francis Olivier, spouse of Theresa Dominge (parents of Francis, b 1833); Francis Olivier, spouse of Louise Curie (parents of Louise b 1840); Jeanne Baptiste Ledeur Cardo, mother of Eugene (b 1846); and Joseph Courtot (c 1797-1850). *StG* mentions these. ALEXANDRE's mother was Colette Ledeur and BARBE's was Jeanne Francoise Courtot (*AOf*).

The above information was gleaned from Registers 3 E 14 1 & 2 of the Archives Départementales de la Haute-Saône in Vesoul. The first witness for MARGUERITE's birth was Pierre Girard (c 1765- , a future father/uncle-in-law?); the second was Antoine Chenevey, the future father-in-law of FRANCOISE. The record states that both men are living in Amblans, and that Pierre Girard is a *laboureur* and Antoine Chenevey a *charon*.

There is a good probability that there are many more children in this family. The researcher was primarily interested in tracing a direct line through Félicien & FRANCOISE Chenevey. This wife of his probably died between 1852 and 1856, when Calmoutier, Ohio, was without a resident pastor, and hardly any burial records were kept. Anyway, she does not appear in the 1860 United States Census, nor anywhere thereafter.

FCf names the following children in this family: Mary, Emile, Joseph, Lucy, Lena, Elizabeth, Paul, Frank, and Charles. It states that 16/17 were born, but that the others did not survive infancy or childhood. Francis Victor above is unknown in the 1870 USC, which gives Salt Creek Twp, Wayne Co as their place of residence, and dry goods merchant as C JOSEPH's occupation.

JOSEPH SARAZIN (*Sarasin* in *StG*) & DANIELLE (whose given name is known only from the passenger list and written in a hard-to-decipher hand, which may indeed be something other than *Danielle*) arrived in New York aboard the Monument 10 Jun 1844, along with the family of their son, FRANCOIS JEANMOUGIN, and that of his brother-in-law, Charles Bresson (born in Amblans).

This passenger list, almost certainly a copy of the list at embarkation, places JOSEPH & DANIELLE immediately after FRANCOIS and his wife but before FRANCOIS' four children. *SBf* (The *Simon Besançon* family record) states that FRANCOIS' mother was the aunt of Simon Besançon; and that after her first husband died, she married a SARAZIN and came to Calmoutier with her only son, where she died and was buried.

That same passenger list clearly indicates the above dates of birth for JOSEPH & DANIELLE. While it seems unlikely DANIELLE would be 15 yrs older than her 2nd husband, it seems even more unlikely that a 77-yr-old woman would pull up stakes and make a rough 5/6-week voyage across the Atlantic to establish a home in the New World. She might, though, if all she has is her willing husband, and her one son and 4 g-children. At any rate DANIELLE is unknown at *StG*, while JOSEPH is supporting the parish until 1851 (when he died?).

The Simon Besançons were very close to the JEANMOUGINS and lived immediately next door to them in France (in Amblans?). When they arrived in America in 1847, they stayed with the JEANMOUGINS (absent from the 1850 USC) until they got settled. *Dora Minder*

FCf knows only the five youngest children. It names MELANIE's husband but not the spouses of CHARLES and EUGENE. All the above children were born in Ohio (USC).

LOUIS & MARIE are buried at Calmoutier. All the surviving children, however, moved either to Michigan or to Canton (FCf). EUGENE located in Cheboygan Co, Michigan near Riggsville, where he had 4 sons and a daughter by Elizabeth, and a daughter by Marie (PMf).

In 1880 this family was living in Salt Creek Twp, Wayne Co.

Before CHARLES & Hattie moved, they had at least 4 daughters: Florence M (29 Aug 1882- ); Lucy Melinda (3 Jun 1886- ); Elmira Matilda (17 Feb 1888- ); and Laura M ( +17 Jul 1887). StG
