Job Summary:

The Programming & Outreach Associate will plan, conduct, and coordinate programming for adults, teens, and youth either at a library location or offsite and include driving the library's outreach van to the program site. The incumbent will also perform circulation duties on the bookmobile, Central Library, and East Branch.

Principle Duties:

- Plans and conducts programs for adults, teens, and children
- Conducts offsite outreach programs and participates in community events including driving the library's outreach van to designated program sites and community events
- Drives the library's outreach van to bookmobile stops
- Selects and delivers materials to homebound patrons
- Cultivates relationships and partnerships between the library and the Holmes County community
- Markets library programs, events, collections, and resources by creating displays, posters, and flyers
- Creates displays featuring library materials
- Performs circulation tasks on the bookmobile, Central Library, or East Branch
- Participates in library-wide initiatives and programs
- Other duties as assigned
